## Management Reports

- A. President-Mark reminded all to get cleaning redwood feathers and speeding around the park needs to be curtailed
- B. Vice President-Cyndy asked all to turn off sprinklers for the season and drains are a big issue right now so let Shelley in the office know if you need help cleaning it out
- C. Secretary-Heather shared the next bulletin deadline is Oct. 24, dues cards are going to be coming in, send to , R & P fines are being revised so it's time to start buckling down and reminding ourselves to do the right thing
- D. Treasurer-Pat shared TADs are going up due to county tax initiatives, only 49 allotments did not respond to the water meter letter, another CD is rolling this month, we are currently at a profit for the year, we will have garbage can reduction during the quiet times to save about \$800 per quarter, fundraising forms must be approved by Board prior to the event, and worker's comp. owes us \$8000, so Pat moved to request a worker's compensation refund, it was seconded, and **approved** 5-0.

E. Director at Large-Bill shared that as the weather changes to be on the watch for the homeless entering the park, call the Sheriff and let the office know, also please don't feed the wildlife so coyotes are not as interested in being here

- D. Recreation-Holly Swanson 577 Scottishrite shared pumpkin carving is coming up, and shared all the other Halloween events, the trick-or-treating map is in the office, Nov. potluck on the 15th will be a Friendsgiving theme, next committee meeting is Nov. 16th, Bunco may happen again on Nov. 23rd, and Bingo will happen Nov. 28th, there will be a Stitch and Munch group starting soon, and a holiday party is planned for Dec. 13th with the turkeys coming out of the Recreation Committee budget.
- E. Safety-Cyndy shared the committee used the gator for practice, Fire Marshall from Cal-Fire visited us, and we have invited him to come and share possible evacuation practices in the near future, and remember to clean allotments of fire debris.

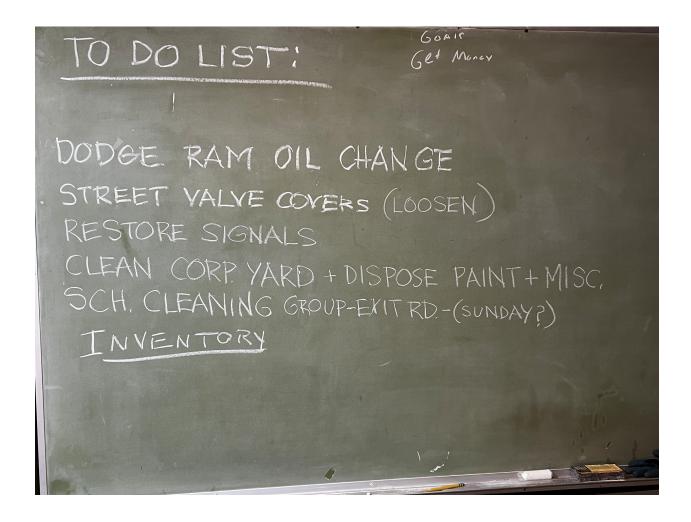

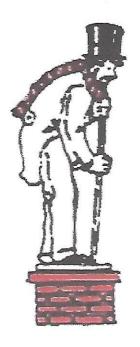

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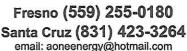
