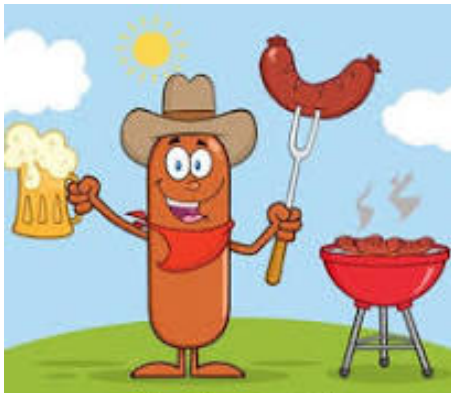




Town Crier 21 July 2024

The list below is of the duties associated with hosting a potluck weenie roast:

Pick up key from the office
Arrive at 4:30 to start the fire and put out the flag. (Flag is in the shed to the left of the door)

Locate kitchen key and put out buns and dogs.\

Unlock back shed and pull out recycling and trash bins

Sweep tables

5:30 people arrive...6:00 prayer, salute and announcements

Invite people to eat and enjoy food and fellowship

Clean up, douse the fire with hose, relock everything

Bring trash cans across the street for

Monday pick up
Turn in key

Host does not need to buy condiments, hotdogs, firewood or s'mores.

Recreation committee supplies these items.

Not knowing how many will attend, we have wine,...but...when it is gone there is NO MORE. It's very difficult to try to determine how many people will attend. By the same token, we are not asking people what foods they are donating...if we get 17 plates of sliced veggies, so be it.....after all, it IS free!

Saturday: July 27 – dinner reservation/packets will be available for pick up in the picnic grounds from 10 until 1 p.m. I understand there are still dinner tickets available, but the price is now \$30. The same holds for the breakfast with the price now \$15. Extra dinner tickets can be purchased in the picnic grounds where you pick up your dinner packet and extra breakfast tickets can be purchased Sunday morning at the door.
